GOD'S PEOPLE: ENSLAVED?

Genesis 12 - Exodus 18

During those many days the king of Egypt died, and the people of Israel groaned because of their slavery and cried out for help. Their cry for rescue from slavery came up to God. And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. God saw the people of Israel--and God knew.

SALVATION BY SUBSTITUTION

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! (John 1:29)

And the disciples did as Jesus had directed them, and they prepared the Passover. (Matt. 26:19)

GOD'S LAW

- Israelites were already God's people by his grace.

 - Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; (Ex. 19:5)

GOD'S RULE & BLESSING

GOD'S LAW

- God's People are to Look Like God (Holy Nation)
 - "and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation." (Ex. 19:6)

GOD'S RULE & BLESSING GOD'S PRESENCE

- The whole purpose of Redemption is Relationship
- The Tabernacle

The Message of The Tabernacle

The tabernacle was given by God as a display of truth. Each item in the tabernacle served as a visual aid, reminding God's people of his character, comforting them with his grace, and assuring them of the hope he extends to sinners.



The Laver God cleanses



- Showed the sinner's need
- Symbolized God's temporary provision
- Pointed to a greater fulfillment in the coming Messiah.



The Altar God saves The Lampstand God gives light to sinners

The Ark God reigns over sinners

The Curtain

The Incense God hears sinners

The Showbread God fellowships with sinners

The Tabernacle

among sinners

God lives





God is *separate* from sinners
